Drinks Reception

On Friday 28th of March, we will hold an invite only Drinks Reception to celebrate the opening of the exhibition and the Centre's involvement with *Wales Week in London*. The invitation list will comprise of board members, recognisable London Welsh figure heads, and the Centre's partners. If you are one of the selected artists, this is a superb opportunity for you to attend the reception and sell your artwork.

Exhibiting Fees

Your collection must fit within **TWO ART DISPLAY BOARDS** ($2m \text{ wide } x 2.5m \text{ high } = 5m^2$). The cost for TWO ART DISPLAY BOARDS is **£100**.

If you require a larger wall space for your artwork, you will be required to pay for **FOUR ART DISPLAY BOARDS** (4m wide x 2.5m high = $10m^2$). The cost for FOUR ART DISPLAY BOARDS is **£200**.

If you will be sending your works via an Art Courier, we will charge an additional **£15** to cover our handling fees. Please note that we are **not responsible for hanging artwork**—this is the

responsibility of the artist. (For further questions, please contact Nicola@londonwelsh.org.)

NEW DISPLAY OPTION:

We are also offering an additional **one-metre-wide display board** (1m wide x 2.5m high) for **£0** as part of our **Complimentary Exhibition Space for Students and Emerging Artists**.

We are committed to supporting emerging talent and providing opportunities for students and new artists to showcase their work. We are pleased to offer a limited amount of **complimentary exhibition space** for individuals looking to display their art in a professional setting, **free of charge**.

This initiative aims to provide a platform for creative expression, encourage artistic growth, and help build connections within the artistic community. If you are a student or emerging artist seeking exhibition space, we would love to hear from you. Please note that these spaces are **limited**.

Commission

All works on display will be available for sale unless otherwise instructed. All artwork sales will be commission-free.

Artists are encouraged to bring additional items such as prints, calendars, or other smaller pieces to supplement their showcased work. A small space, such as a print rack or a modest table, can be used for this purpose. We kindly advise limiting the quantity to a manageable selection that can be replenished as needed throughout the event.

Additionally, you are welcome to paint or create artwork during your time here, as long as it does not disrupt other artists.

Payments

 Please note – Payments for any purchases will need to be made directly to the seller. The London Welsh Centre will not be able to process any transaction. This can be done by BACS payments or through personal card devices. Please feel free to bring personal payment devices or have your details to hand.

Delivery/Collection of Works

<u>*Please note Exhibition Boards will be going up on Thursday evening – so hanging will not be possible</u> <u>until after this time. *</u>

Art Hanging to take place on Friday - between 9am and 4:30pm - Date 28/03/2025

Where possible, Works should be delivered **in person** on the date specified. The Works must arrive **wrapped** with the forms and labels provided by LWC attached. A member of staff will meet with Artists to receive the Works, and will witness and document its condition on arrival. (LWC Staff Cannot hang your work)

If you are unable to deliver your work in person, we recommend using a professional **Art Courier**, <u>at your</u> <u>own expense</u>. The Works must arrive on the date specified, **wrapped** with the forms and labels provided by LWC attached. A member of staff will receive the Works, and take a photo of its condition. We will email to confirm its arrival.

Where possible, Works should be collected **in person** on the date(s) specified. (Please note that we cannot wrap Works for collection in person.)

If you are unable to collect your work in person, we recommend using a professional **Art Courier**, <u>at your</u> <u>own expense</u>. You will need to provide sufficient material for our staff to rewrap the Works. You are required to email the LWC with all the collection details and access to the tracker.

Parking

- Parking has changed on Gray's Inn Road due to a Cycle Lane Drop off will be possible (Quick drop off) but as it stands; the Centre will not be arranging any additional parking, meaning that it is the responsibility of the Artists to find their own suitable parking.
- The cheapest carparks in the area are the NCP (Try it online for cheaper parking) on Judd Street and the Travelodge Farringdon NCP and Wren Street across from the centre (Timed parking so please look it up before arrival).

<u>Liability</u>

- Artists agree that the Centre has no responsibility to provide security or insurance to cover their property.
- Therefore, Artists must promise and warrant that they carry insurance sufficient to cover any damage, loss or theft of their property if necessary.
- The London Welsh Centre and Artist agree that any disputes arising under this Agreement will be resolved via a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process.

Marketing/Publicity

If you're a Welsh artist, this is a wonderful opportunity to get some great exposure for your work to a London-based audience; including the many Welsh people (some 60,000+ in London) who love to pick up something to remind them of home and to satisfy their Welsh creative and cultural sensibilities.

Submissions should be filled out on the Jot form on the Website. <u>www.londonwelsh.org</u>

- Completed 'Artist's Submission JotForm'.
- Digital image(s) of your work.
 Must be .jpg or .pdf files with a minimum of 920 pixels at the smallest dimension. Images can be a maximum of 2 MB in size. Please name each image file with the Entry Name of the piece. You must submit at least one image per entry.
- \circ $\;$ Await confirmation from the Exhibition Administrators.
- Once you have received confirmation:
 - Familiarise yourself with the T&C's; sign and return the document.
 - Ensure prompt payment for your display wall space.
